Settlement Housing Fund

Since 1969 Settlement Housing Fund has developed 56 projects with over 8,700 apartments – rentals, cooperatives and two-family houses – that are home to more than 25,000 low and middle income New York City residents. Whenever possible we incorporate commercial developments and community programs for children, young adults and families that provide opportunities for educational success and upward mobility.

Our newest development called Semiperm provides formerly homeless single parent families with housing and supportive services in preparation for independent living, and we continue our work to preserve affordable housing in Harlem and Washington Heights and to market 80/20 buildings.

We are also partnering with the NYC School Construction Authority to create a Community Campus in the Bronx where our largest development, New Settlement Apartments, provides 995 units of quality housing and excellent community programming. This energy-efficient facility will include a Community Center with pool, dance, art and community space (including a green roof terrace) attached to a new pre-K – 12th grade public school.
